The Easter Tridium

This begins with The Mass of The Lord's Supper on Thursday evening. This Mass is a Memorial of The Institution of The Eucharist, in which Christ gives Himself to us, in His Body and Blood and also a Memorial of The Institution of the Priesthood by which Christ's Mission and Sacrifice are perpetuated to the world.

On Good Friday The Church meditates on The Passion and Death of her Lord and Spouse, venerates The Cross and intercedes for the salvation of the world. Mass is not celebrated on this day.

On Holy Saturday the Church waits at the tomb of The Lord – it is a day of reflection and for allowing the Lord to speak through silence. The day concludes with the most solemn celebration of the year – The Easter Vigil - . The lighting and blessing of the Paschal Fire and the singing of the Exultet leads to the joy of the expectation of the Saviour. The somewhat more elaborate readings from the scriptures remind us of the hope of all Christians to enjoy the promise of The Resurrection. St. Augustine called The Easter Vigil "The Mother of All Vigils".
