Holy Thursday & Good Friday

With The Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening, the Church begins the sacred Easter Triduum, celebrating the paschal mystery of the crucifixion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus. This Mass, is, first of all, the memorial of the institution of the Eucharist in which Christ gives himself to us in the sacrament of his Body and Blood. The Mass of the Lord's Supper is also the memorial of the institution of the priesthood, by which Christ's mission and sacrifice are perpetuated in the world. In addition, this Mass commemorates Christ washing his disciples' feet and his commandment to love one another as he has loved us. On Good Friday The Church meditates on the Passion and Death of her Lord and Spouse, venerates the Cross, commemorates her origin from the pierced side of Christ on Calvary, and intercedes for the salvation of the world. On this day, in accordance with ancient tradition, the Holy Mass is not celebrated.
