St. Brigid's N.S. – 180 Years On.

On Monday May 12th 1834, The Presentation Sisters opened their school for the children of Midleton. Great numbers turned out. During the awful years of the Great Famine the sisters from their meagre resources and with the help of contributions from benefactors provide meals for over 200 children. By 1850 there were 700 pupils and 29 sisters in the school.

To mark the occasion, on Monday 12th May, exactly 180 years later our 6th Classes presented a moving Prayer Service. We were delighted that six of the sisters could join us for the celebration. It is fitting at a time like this to thank the sisters and congratulate them on their contribution to the Education of so many young people in Midleton and beyond!
