Praying With Your Phone.

Yes, your smartphone or Ipad can now be used for prayer. All the texts of the Mass for each day, Sunday and Weekdays are available as an App for your phone. One is called UNIVERSALIS, from the App store. It also contains the full Divine office as recited each day by Priests and Religious and by very many Lay People. Many priests and religious have now gone over totally to the Iphone/iPad for the Divine Office rather than the traditional Breviary.

Another App gives you a Thought for the Day on your phone: its called *PORTA FIDEI* (*Gateway to Faith*).

An App giving Christian Teaching is called *COMPENDIUM*. A fascinating App called *3 MINUTE RETREAT* gives you what it says, a guided pause for reflection in your day. This has a huge following worldwide and is done by the Irish Jesuits.

The App POPE FRANCIS, allows you to follow the Pope each day in his teachings. Finally, there are several versions of the Bible available on your phone or iPad for daily reading or study or meditation.
