Receiving Holy Communion for the First Time Midleton Parish, 28th April – 26thth May 2018



Over four Saturdays in April and May, and after preparation with their families, schools and parish representatives, roughly 220 boys and girls from Midleton parish will receive Holy Communion for the first time. The following are the relevant dates: Sat 28th April – pupils from Ballintotas NS; Sat 12th May – pupils from CBS P.S.; Sat 19th May – pupils from St Brigid's P.S., Educate Together N.S. and St John the Baptist N.S.; Sat 27th May – pupils from Gaelscoil Mhainistir Na Corann. All of these ceremonies take place in Holy Rosary Church except for that of 28th May, which takes place in St Colman's church Ballintotas.

The importance of Mass (the Eucharist) and receiving Holy Communion:

- During the Last Supper, Jesus said to the apostles "This is my body given up for you" and "This is my blood poured out for you". The Mass makes the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus present to us so that we may apply His great sacrifice to our own lives. In Mass, we offer ourselves to God "through Jesus, with Jesus and in Jesus".
- In Holy Communion, Jesus is really present and shares himself with us, giving us his virtues, his strengths and his holiness. "I am the bread come down from heaven".
- Through Holy Communion we make a strong bond of love with Christ and with the other members of the Church. Through Holy Communion we all partake of the same meal and, so, together we pledge loyalty to Christ and His Church.
- Prayer after Holy Communion. Lord Jesus, I love and adore you. You're a special friend to me. Welcome, Lord Jesus, O welcome, thank you for coming to me. Thank you, Lord Jesus, O thank you for giving yourself to me. Make me strong to show your love wherever I may be. Be near me, Lord Jesus, I ask you to stay close by me forever and love me, I pray. Bless all of us children in your loving care and bring us to heaven to live with you there. I'm ready now, Lord Jesus, to show how much I care. I'm ready now to give your love at home and everywhere. Amen.
