Indulgences for the Holy Souls

Visiting a church: A Plenary Indulgence can be got for the Souls in Purgatory by 1. Visiting a Church on All Souls Day, and saying One Our Father and The Apostles Creed.

2. A Plenary Indulgence can be got for The Souls in Purgatory by visiting a Cemetery and praying mentally for The Departed. It may be obtained each day from 1st to the 8th November.

Conditions for gaining a Plenary Indulgence: Visiting a Church, Sacramental Confession, Reception of Holy Communion and praying for the Pope's Intentions (One Our Father, One Hail Mary).

All Saints

The ultimate object of veneration of the Saints is the glory of God and the sanctification of man by conforming one's life fully to the divine will and by imitating the virtue of those who were pre-eminent disciples of the Lord. Catechesis and other forms of doctrinal instruction should therefore make known to the faithful that our relationship with the Saints must be seen in the light of Faith and should not obscure the "cultus latriae" due to God The Father through Christ in The Holy Spirit, but intensify it.
