Saint Joseph's Young Priests' Society

The Society's Founder was Mrs. Olivia Mary Taaffe (nee Blake),
born in Co. Galway, on June 24th 1832. Her sister Harriet entered the
Presentation Order of Sisters Midleton in 1862, taking the religious name of Sister
Ignatius. Olivia was present at her reception into the Order and was a frequent
visitor to her. Sr. Ignatius taught at St. Mary's School Midleton until her death, on
27th May 1888 having spent 26 years serving the people of Midleton. She is interred
in The Order's Burial Plot, at The Old Convent Grounds. If you wish to know
