**Jean Vanier, the founder of L'Arche,** has written:

We must learn to rest in that peace which comes when God touches our hearts. We must know that this peace is the presence of God, that this is how God speaks to us, through this love which touches us at the core and flows through all our being and plunges us into silence. We must be open to this peace. One of the most beautiful Easter stories is where the Risen Jesus meets the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. As we remember the presence of the Risen Christ this week, we, too, can beg him to stay with us. It is a good time to reflect on where we most need love, the guidance, the encouragement of Jesus now! After prayer, do we invite him to stay with us? It reminds us how near The Risen Christ is to us and it affirms our deep belief that we need this presence in our life.
